## Did you know ?

- The church has to pay for everything it does. This includes clergy salaries and pensions, heating, insurance, building maintenance and a host of other expenses.
- St James's has a **Planned Giving scheme**, whereby church members and supporters give a regular amount each week, month, quarter or year. This known income enables the parish to budget for all its expenses.
- The Parochial Church Council is responsible for the church's finances and is seeking to be a prudent and responsible steward on behalf of all church members.
- St. James's has been affected by the 'credit crunch' with 20% of the value of our investments being lost in 2008, though in 2009 a small part of that loss was recovered.

## How much should I give ?

The church suggests you think about giving 5% of your net income (after tax). This works out at:

Net monthly income	2%	5%	10%

**Planned Giving in 2009** was £66,600 before Gift Aid, but this was £1800 less than in 2008.  
At the very least we need to make up the shortfall if we are to meet our commitments as a church.

## How is our money spent?

Our payment to the London Diocese in 2010 of £72,060.

This is our share of a Common Fund to which all London parishes contribute. It ensures the church has a presence in **every** part of our city - rich and poor alike.

The diocese covers the cost of:

- Clergy (pay, housing and pensions)
- Training future clergy, readers and lay workers
- Working with children, young people and vulnerable adults

And we have to find funds to HELP finance:

- Our church and witness here in Hampton Hill (e.g. utilities, buildings insurance and maintenance, organist, Sunday school, magazine)
- Our charitable donations: we give a proportion of our annual income to local, national and international charities.
