The Great West Window 'Transfiguration of Christ' (c1882)


This is a memorial window dedicated to the Revd Fitz Wygram bearing the inscription: *"To the Glory of God and in loving remembrance of Fitzroy John Fitzwygram, first vicar of this parish 1863-1881*

"This window is erected by his parishioners and friends

"'A faithful man and feared God' He entered into rest August 13th 1881"

It is at the west end of the church, above the porch, the original of which was also built in Revd Fitz Wygram's memory.

£500 was collected by public subscription for these memorials.





High above the nave at the entrance to the chancel is a tiny window depicting the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove
